APPROVED PROFESSIONAL FEES AND CHARGES BY THE GHANA MEDICAL ASSOCIATION (GMA) FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY MEDICAL DOCTORS AND DENTISTS

The National Executive Council (NEC) of the Ghana Medical Association (GMA) has approved a review of the Approved professional fees and charges for use by members and all persons who require professional services of members of GMA.

On behalf of NEC, I have subsequently, written to the Ministry of Health notifying the ministry of the reviewed rates and also requested that the document be brought to the attention of all agencies, facilities, managers and all other stakeholders (public and private) and also to ensure the necessary cooperation for its smooth implementation.

I am by this letter notifying you, our members, of the reviewed fees and charges and also that copies have been made available to Divisional Chairpersons for onward dissemination to members. Electronic versions would also be made available to members via our portals.

Kindly note that the stated professional fees and charges are the actual payments to be received by doctors through administrative processes of the facilities.

The effective Date for the implementation of the approved fees and charges is 1st June, 2024.

Members are advised to adhere to the approved fees and charges as approved by the Council at all times.

APPROVED FEES AND CHARGES BY THE GHANA MEDICAL ASSOCIATION (GMA) FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY ITS MEMBERS-MEDICAL DOCTORS AND DENTISTS

Introduction

These approved fees and charges cover selected professional services rendered by medical doctors and dentists in publicly and privately-owned health facilities, public or privately owned non-health institutions, individuals, or entities. They do not cover salaries to be earned by these professionals. Some important factors that were taken into consideration in arriving at these final figures include the fact that healthcare provision in Ghana is dominated by public health facilities as well as the rural-urban disparities in the distribution of healthcare facilities, personnel, and incomes.

The fees categories cover Police Forms, Medical Reports, Medical Opinions, Autopsies & Death Certificates, and Locums.

These fees and charges remain in force until amended.
