Executive Summary

- In 1998, Prof Oheneba Boachie-Adjei, a world renowned orthopedic surgeon, created the Foundation of Orthopedics and Complex Spine (FOCOS) to help bring treatment of complex spinal deformities to underserved populations, primarily in Africa.
- Since inception, FOCOS has treated over 75,000 patients and performed more than 3,500 complex surgeries on patients from over 55 countries. These surgeries cost 85-95% less than the cost to perform the same procedures in the US.
- More than 85% of all severe scoliosis cases at FOCOS occur among children, young adults, and populations who cannot afford the cost of treatment and care. Of the cases treated at FOCOS, 56% are life-threatening. Apart from shorter lifespans, victims of scoliosis go through pain, stigma, unproductive lives, unhappiness, and experience poor mental health as a consequence of coping with scoliosis within their communities.
- Driven by a strong culture of excellence in patient care, FOCOS has a medical team comprised of 43 doctors, 95 nurses and other well-trained medical staff, who have outstanding track records of experience and skills.
- FOCOS operates with high standards to ensure total wellness and care and has some of the lowest infection rates among hospitals, worldwide.
- FOCOS delivers world class solutions to complex human development problems and has a distinguished affiliation with the Hospital for Special Surgery (HSS).





- FOCOS was approved as an affiliate of HSS for the use of Premier contracts to purchase supplies.



Severe Idiopathic Kyphoscoliosis

FOCOS intervention

Diagnosis:

- Severe Idiopathic Kyphoscoliosis
 - Sideways curvature of the spine along with forward rounding of the back
 - Tilted gait, Difficulty with posture and walking
 - Occasional but significant back pain
 - Difficulty in breathing

Treatment:

- Halo gravity traction for a month
 - Spinal Fusion Surgery along with Thoracoplasty
 - An advanced procedure involving cutting of parts of ribs to allow for the relaxation of the chest wall and better movement of the spine before correction
 - Nutritional Optimization

Outcome:

- Improved posture, walking and standing ability
- Improved self-image and overall health.
- Can breathe with ease, with no complaints of back pain

FOCOS intervention

Diagnosis:

- Neuromuscular Scoliosis: Curvature of the spine resulting from multiple skeletal defects
 - Inability to walk unassisted due to weakness in legs and arms
 - Inability to fully appreciate sense of touch
 - Shortness of breath

Treatment:

- Halo gravity traction for ten weeks
- Posterior Spinal Fusion
- Nutritional Optimization

Outcome:

- Improved posture and breathing capability
- Improved self-image and overall health
- Can breathe with ease and also sleep well at night
- Better bowel and bladder functionality

Arthrogryposis

FOCOS intervention

Diagnosis:

- Arthrogryposis: congenital joint contracture in both upper and lower extremity joints
 - Unstable gait with club feet
 - Inability to grasp or hold objects properly

Treatment:

- Osteotomy of left knee with plates and screws for joint stability
- Fusion of Selected gaps in the joints of the left foot
- Shortening of the right tibia to achieve relatively equal leg length
- Triple arthrodesis of right foot for better stability
- Multiple procedures on right elbow and wrist. Stabilized with plates and screws
- Soft tissue releases on the elbow. Tendon transfers and bone fusions on the wrist

Outcome:

- Improved gait and overall stability
- Improved self-image and overall health
- Improved ability to grasp most objects

Diagnosis:

- Neurofibromatosis with Thoracolumbar Scoliosis
 - Tilted gait
 - Tendency for the spine not to achieve proper fusion
 - Difficulty with posture and walking

Treatment:

- Spinal Fusion Surgery
 - Highly advanced spinal procedure utilizing rods and screws to keep the spine straight
 - Addition of bone graft to the spine to enhance Fusion

Outcome:

- Improved posture and height
- Improved self-image and overall health
- Can sleep well at night

Total cost of care:


